The next morning in church, a man gave me some money, saying God had told him to do so. It was the same amount of money I had spent on the cab fare and tip. Our Father certainly pays attention to details! Isn't He Wonderful?!

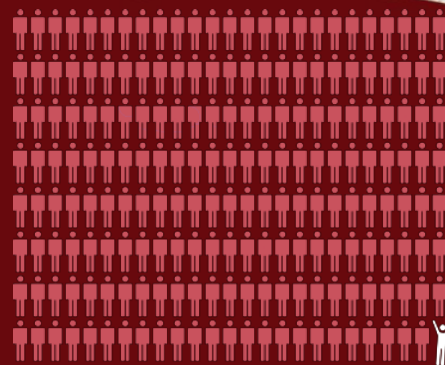
The Need in France
